These are God's **Means of Grace**. (examples: Word of God, Baptism, Absolution, Lord's Supper)

4. In one sentence what is the sermon trying to teach us about God and our faith?

This is the **Theme**. (It is based on the **Law** and **Means of Grace**, but especially the **Gospel**)

5. What does this change about how we live and think?

This is our **Response**. (God is always calling us to live as His children)

6. What did you hear in the service connected to the sermon? What did you find interesting?

This points to the **Liturgy**. (example: a procession, the choir singing, a familiar term in a hymn)
